Trill & Flute Fingering Chart

TRILL CHART

A trill should always be made to the next note in the key signature, unless indicated by an accidental after the trill sign (ex. $\text{tr}\sharp$ )
Trill those keys indicated in RED, while covering keys indicated in BLACK.
